

Comprehensive Continuous Emergency Preparedness Readiness Webinar Series

Overview

OHA is offering a four-part webinar series on continuous emergency preparedness readiness. This opportunity is funded by the Administration for Strategic Preparedness and Response (ASPR) to provide workforce support for healthcare professionals, both on an ongoing basis and in the event of an infectious outbreak or future pandemic response.

Learning Objectives

At the end of the series, participants will be able to:

- Describe elements of a comprehensive continuous emergency preparedness model of readiness.
- Discuss the current healthcare emergency preparedness landscape and the application of effective strategies that emerged from the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Identify key opportunities for improvement in emergency management preparedness in your organization.
- Describe the process of identifying risks, hazards, and threats to your healthcare operations.
- Describe the critical elements of an Emergency Operations Plan, including the role of senior leadership in a response.
- Compare and contrast your hospital Emergency Operations Plan to a model Emergency Operations Plan.
- Discuss challenges and success in the execution of effective emergency management in your hospital setting.
- Discuss adapting your emergency management response in a dynamic emergency environment.
- Identify the role of training, exercises, and community/state partnerships, in continuous improvement.

Sessions

September 10 - Emergency Management Risk Assessment

This session will reimagine emergency preparedness in a post-pandemic world. The presenters will identify risks, hazards, and threats to healthcare operations and safety using a robust Hazard Vulnerability Analysis.

September 12 - Emergency Management Planning

This session will offer ways to strengthen your planning process for the six critical elements of an Emergency Operations Plan, including communications, staffing, patient clinical and support activities, safety and security, resources and assets, and utilities.

October 8 - Emergency Management Response

This session will discuss leading practices and their challenges in the execution of effective emergency management. This will include ways to modify and manage operations in a dynamic emergency environment.

October 10 - Emergency Management Evaluation

This session will discuss the role of training exercises and evaluation in continuous improvement and ways the application of exercises and events can strengthen emergency preparedness.
