Target Audience: infection prevention staff in acute care hospitals, including those who are new or need a refresher.

OHA's *IP Bootcamp*, is a 6-month program developed to inform and inspire infection prevention teams seeking practical and innovative approaches to building a strong and effective infection prevention program. The IP Bootcamp includes an in-person kickoff meeting, followed by four monthly webinars.

Topics will include foundational aspects of an infection prevention program; conducting an infection control risk assessment; healthcare-associated infections; employee health issues and the role of the IP; and the environment and equipment, including disinfection and sterilization overview.

This opportunity is funded by the Administration for Strategic Preparedness and Response (ASPR) to provide workforce support for healthcare professionals, both on an ongoing basis and in the event of an infectious outbreak or future pandemic response.

Registration is \$15 per person to cover refreshments and lunch at the kickoff meeting on Sept. 28.

Learning Objectives

- Discuss the role and responsibilities of the Infection Preventionist (IP), strategies for personal and professional prosperity, key tools designed to perform a risk assessment for the Infection Prevention Program, conducting an outbreak investigation, and guidance on ways to prevent disease transmission.
- Discuss strategies that will promote the IP's ability to engage others and influence practices that prevent healthcare-associated infections such as CAUTI, CLABSI, SSI, CDI, MDRO, and HOB.
- Describe key strategies designed to promote safe processing and cleaning of equipment and the environment including during construction, renovation, and potential water exposures.
- Discuss data analysis and display to drive improvement.
- Describe strategies for selecting and getting started on an IP Performance Improvement Project.
- Discuss the basics of microbiology and connect the dots to diagnostic stewardship, such as culturing practices.
- Describe strategies for survey readiness through teamwork and accountability.
- Discuss strategies to promote staff wellness through immunizations, health screening, and exposure management.
